- Serve on residential crisis response team
- Oversee residential program planning and assessment that enhances student learning and academic success
- Implement department and campus initiatives through meeting and committee involvement

In addition, the position provides general support for the entire Student Activities and Residential Life & Housing missions, including, but not limited to, on-site supervision for department-sponsored and campus-wide programs, assistance with new initiatives, as well as being familiar with all policies and procedures related to student organizations and event planning.
